

The Welcome Address was delivered by **Ms. Navneet Kaur**, highlighting the institute's commitment to academic excellence, innovation, and global engagement.


### Addresses by Eminent Dignitaries



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## Brief Report

The IQAC of Asian Educational Institute, Patiala, in collaboration with the International Council for Education Research and Training (ICERT), organized a two-day international multidisciplinary conference in hybrid mode on 17-18 February 2026. The theme of the conference was "Inclusive Futures: Sustainable Development through Science, Education, Language, and Social Justice." The conference was dedicated to the United Nations International Day of Women and Girls in Science, International Mother Language Day, and World Day of Social Justice.

The conference commenced with the ceremonial lighting of the lamp by Shri Tarsem Saini and Dr. Meenu Singh Sachan., Dr. Sapna Rathore (Convener).

Dr. Paramjit Kaur, and Dr. Payal Tangri (Co-ordinators) introduced the conveners and all Key note speakers and ICERT Organising Committee & highlighted their academic achievements. Ms. Navneet Kaur & Ms. Harjeet Kaur welcomed the keynote speakers and invited them to share their views on the conference's theme, "Inclusive Futures: Sustainable Development through Science, Education, Language, and Social Justice."

Tarsem Saini, and the Principal, Dr. Meenu Singh Sachan, honoured the conveners and coordinators with awards (Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose, Global Excellence Awards) for the conference.
